

Dear motor enthusiast,

Once again a big thank you to you all for getting behind the 7th annual concourse car and bike show, for those enthusiast that haven't been to this show before, this is some information on the general running of the event.

This year's show is on Sunday 16<sup>th</sup> of September from 10:00am – 1:00pm. We would like to get all participants to arrive at the shopping centre to park between 8:00 and 9:30, so we everyone parked before 10:00am. For anyone that hasn't been to the Concourse before we are located on Reserve Rd Beaumaris. The shopping centre is basically a big square so the cars will be parked in the parallel parking, which is on the right hand side of the shopping centre all the way around, and then it will join back through the main car parking area at the front of the centre adjacent to the grassland area to join the two sides. We also have the use of the grassland area at the front of the centre which we use for Motorbikes and large club involvements so they can be all together. The Beaumaris Rotary Club will be assisting in parking everyone, we want to do the best to keep friends and clubs grouped together, but is a lot easier if you want to be in a group to turn up together. If clubs can let me know numbers attending the week leading up the event, I will allocate the number of parking spaces they require.

Due to the increase in popularity of the event this year we ask that you pre-register for the event by sending me your name, contact details (phone and email), vehicle make/model and registration number. Like last year there will be trophies for best in show as voted by the general public for people's choice, there will be a first, second and third for both cars and for bikes. Rather than having a judge this year I will be giving each entrant a voting slip to vote on what they think are the best in each category.

There is a \$10.00 entry fee per vehicle which will go to the Beaumaris Rotary Club who give their time to assist with running the event. All money will go back into the local community through Rotary projects. Last year we raised just over \$1800.00 and we hope to beat that this year.

Other attractions on the day are Firetruck rides, Roaming performers, and live music on the grassland area, free face painting, great food and local Bayside police display. Clubs are also welcome to set up a table, banners, etc. or advertise their club on the day.
