1972 TRIUMPH MKII 2.5 PI – “Wilbur”

There is some reluctance in the family to move “Wilbur” on. We purchased “Wilbur” in Canberra in 1987 from its second owner. “Wilbur” was the first car for our four daughters as they moved into motoring with education and their first jobs – so, there is some significant “attachment” to “Wilbur”. For over ten years “Wilbur” has been registered and stored locally in a garage – started regularly and driven every four weeks or so. Currently “Wilbur” has ACT historic registration which allows for limited road use but is not transferable.

Over the last several months we have “gone over” “Wilbur”. Mechanical inspections – monitoring and tune up of the petrol injection system – overall check and adjustments to transmission and brakes – detailing of body inside and out.

I estimate that “Wilbur” is 95% “original”. There are some upholstery repair works to do inside for the front seats.

“Wilbur” is now ready for sale to someone who might be interested in looking at “Wilbur” for the “next life”.

In addition to the car, the sale could include an important range of PI equipment and a Triumph MK I 2.5 PI workshop manual. (We had a MK I PI before “Wilbur” – there was no need for a separate manual for the MKII).
