Point Nepean HERITAGE MOTOR SHOW

To All Heritage Motor Enthusiasts:

The ROTARY Club of Sorrento is staging the inaugural Point Nepean Heritage Motor Show as a community activity for all to enjoy.

This event is the first step towards establishing a new local tradition, that - in line with the manifesto of the Rotary Club to raise funds for local and international charities – intends to mobilise all interested car lovers to support the worthy cause of addressing the homelessness on the Mornington Peninsula. Mums, dads, kids, older people and younger people are being forced from their homes during this current housing crisis. With nowhere affordable to go, they are living in their cars or in tents amongst the bushes. Each day *Southern Peninsula Community Support* is on the front line providing vital food, hot showers and material aid to nearly 2,000 of the Peninsula's most vulnerable people and their families.

The aim of this event is – over and beyond fundraising for a good cause – to bring community groups together to appreciate a large-scale presentation of many of the state's most significant heritage motorcars and motorcycles while enjoying music, local food and refreshments.

The location of the event is the iconic Point Nepean Quarantine Station, a popular target destination for many weekend outings and a spectacular backdrop for the show. Surrounded by the natural beauty of the environment, we are aspiring to attract several hundreds of classic vehicles. The display cars will be staged in categories according to their heritage (please refer to the attached site plan).

Vehicle categories (cars and motorcycles) we are inviting are as follows, categorised according to their year of manufacture:

- VETERAN – up to 1919 (AREA 4 – arrive between 7 and 9am)
- VINTAGE – between 1920 and 1930 (AREA 5 - arrive between 7 and 9am)
- POST-VINTAGE – between 1931 and 1949 (AREA 6 - arrive between 8 and 10am)
- HERITAGE – between 1950 and 1970 (AREA 6 - arrive between 8 and 10am)
- CLASSICS – post 1970 (AREA 3 – arrive between 9 and 11am)

- MOTORCYCLES – AREA 2 – arrive anytime, no later than 10am
- CARS WITH TRAILERS – arrive anytime, no later than 10am)

Please note the display premises are outdoors, hence exposed to rain.

Visitors to this show will be entitled and encouraged to vote, the results of which will be announced during the award ceremony and presentation.

Entrance fee for the event is \$20 for every car including the driver.

Adult visitors' entry fee is \$5. Children are free to enter.

No dogs allowed in the National Park.
