The Florence Thomson Tour is proudly brought to you by the Association of Motoring Club (AOMC) on behalf of RACV In February 1905, Florence Thomson was the sole female entrant in the Dunlop Reliability Motor contest from Sydney to Melbourne. Mrs Thomson was one of the 16 entrants who successfully completed the five-day trial, driving a six horsepower Wolseley, over what was then nothing more than 562 miles of dirt track between the capital cities.

To celebrate the pioneering spirit and contribution of women to Australian motoring, The Florence Thomson Tour was created as an annual event in April 2017 by the RACV.







2024 Florence Thomson Tour Details 26th - 28th April 2024

Ladies, the Florence Thomson Tour for female drivers in classic cars is happening again. We will be based in beautiful Gippsland, not so far from Melbourne this time for an easier Friday night commute.

Proceedings will get underway with an informal meal and renewal of old friendships and the beginnings of new on the evening of Friday 26 th . At this gathering we will check you in and you will receive your Goodies Bag complete with instructions for the weekend. Saturday morning, we will gather at a quaint country hall for a delicious breakfast before you depart on the driving tour of your choice. The short tour of approximately 52kms will take you through beautiful rolling rural country without major hills to our lunch destination. The return journey is approximately the same distance through similar country and will give a total about 110kms for the day. The long tour will venture into the foothills of the Alps for a slightly more challenging drive, arriving at our lunch destination after approximately 98kms. The return journey will be about 56kms, making about 160kms for the day.

Saturday night is our formal Awards Night Dinner.

Sunday morning sees a farewell breakfast at another very interesting venue, highly suitable for the display of our cars.
