On Saturdays and Sundays the Club is open to the public from 11am to 4pm. Members are normally on site by 10am but if you require the gates open earlier we will do our best to make this work – please contact the Secretary in advance to make appropriate arrangements.

We allow Clubs hosting events at our Club to put up external signage on our front fence to the right of the main entrance. Signage must be well-attached to the fence, not overly big and removed on the day of your event.

Visitor Parking

Visitor / Non-Exhibitor cars are to be parked outside the Club grounds in the carparks either side of the main entrance

Disabled parking spots are to the left of the main entrance

Railway crossings

Our Club has two railway crossings, one at each end of the site

On Sundays, your Club must have a traffic marshal at the main entrance to manage vehicle interactions with our miniature railway which has right of way at all times

Trains have right of way at all times

Please obey all internal signage related to our train operations

On-Site Parking Run Days

(Run Days are held on the last Sunday of the month except December)

The Arena (gravel area at the front with the dragline in the middle) is unavailable for use unless agreed prior

All roadways are to be kept clear

The BBQ area and Club Rooms are unavailable for use unless agreed prior

No parking in the areas between all sheds and do not park in front of shed doors

If parking on roadways, then only park on one side of the roadway

Preferred vehicle flows

On Sundays, your Club must have a traffic marshal at the main entrance to manage vehicle interactions with our miniature railway which has right of way at all times

10kph speed limit (walking pace) on site at all times

Pedestrians have right of way

Vehicle flows are shown in yellow

Roadways to be avoided at all times are shown in red

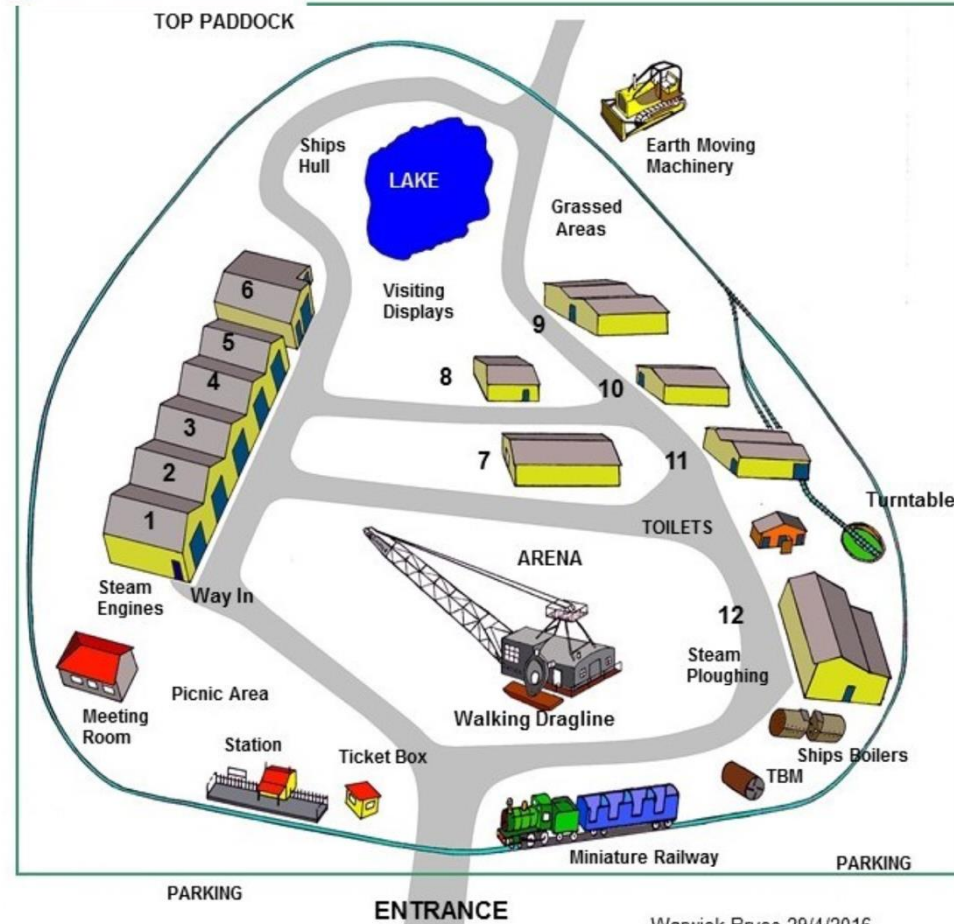
